GREATER FOX CITIES USBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament is open to Greater Fox Cities USBCBA youth members only.
2. USBC Youth eligibility rules will be strictly enforced. 18-year-olds that have sanctioned, or bowled, in an adult league are prohibited from bowling in this tournament (Rule 400).
3. USBC Youth rules and regulations will govern the tournament. Bowling balls must meet USBC specifications.
4. The tournament will be conducted on a team, doubles, and singles basis as indicated on the entry form. Bowlers can qualify for USBC youth individual awards. COACHES will apply for awards earned, based on entering average, in the same manner as when earned in league play, but use Greater Fox Cities Youth Tournament.
5. Entrants are required to wear proper bowling attire. Collared or bowling shirts and slacks are preferred. Prohibited articles of clothing include, but not limited to, hats, headgear, sunglasses, sleeveless shirts, tanks tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, short shorts/short skirts, offensive language and pictures, drug paraphernalia.
6. All bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn. Any abnormal delay can result in a zero for that frame.
7. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the team, doubles or singles entering average and 230 for each division and class.

8. Bowlers of different ages may bowl as a team. Teams may be all boys, girls, or mixed.
9. All entrants should check in at least **30 minutes before the start of his/her shift.**
10. Falsification on any entry will result in automatic disqualification of the entire team, doubles, and singles.
11. Bowlers will use last season's highest league average, as found on Bowl.com. New bowlers, (this year), will use highest current average (minimum of 12 games). **You must send sheets to verify new bowler's average.** All others will enter with an assigned average.
 - 11 years of age and under – 135 average
 - 12-15 years of age and over – 170 average
 - 16 years of age and over – 190 average
 - Special situations will be handled by tournament committee
12. If a bowler participates in more than one league, he/she is eligible to bowl team event once for each league he/she is certified in, provided the league certification application has been received in the Association Manager's office by the tournament entry deadline.
13. Trophies or scholarships will be awarded to each class on a ratio of 1:5 teams, doubles, and singles.
14. TIES – In case of a tie for first place in any division: Co-Champions will be declared. This will be the same for any trophy position.
